2026 promises to be another exciting year in school with lots of fun activities planned in!

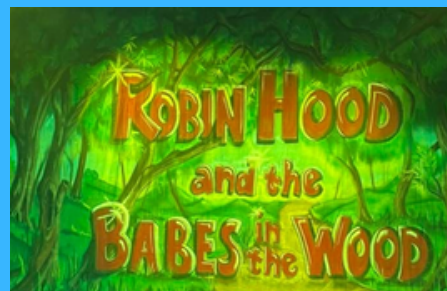
It has been lovely hearing all about the children's Christmas adventures and presents. It sounds like we will have lots of budding gymnasts and Lego creators!

2026 Learning Has Begun!

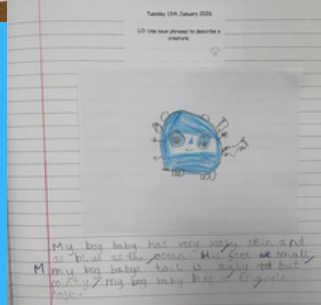
This week we have had lots of fun learning around school and it has been great to hear the children talking about this.
